Community Overlay Approved

On Tuesday, April 23, 2013 at the Lincoln County Commissioners' Meeting held in Star Valley Ranch's Town Hall, a unanimous vote of approval was given for the Star Valley Ranch Community Overlay application for various Zoning changes. These changes address several issues, but the most important is:

- Over 60 additional "Land Use" options will be classified as "Conditional"
 - "Conditional" does not ...
 - mean prohibited
 - affect existing platted subdivisions
 - affect established businesses
 - "Conditional" does ...
 - mean that anyone in the Star Valley Ranch Community Overlay planning to develop land for one of the "conditional land use" businesses must request approval for those land use options in this classification via the Lincoln County Planning and Zoning Board and then the Lincoln County Commissioners.
 - Prior to approval, the County Planning and Zoning Board will:
 - advertise the requested change and
 - hold a public hearing to gather input from the community at large.

This is very important to all who may be affected by a specific land use.

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SVRA Barn/Silo Redevelopment Moves Forward

“Planning continues for a 12-month, multi-use facility...” was the beginning sentence of the last year’s “SVRA 2012 Summer Update” distributed in May 2012 to all members of SVRA with the Annual Election Packet! That statement reflected 24 months of concentrated efforts and analysis of various approaches to resolving the issue of an aging barn/silo complex that was in disrepair, not functional for use by our year-round residents, and in need of serious investment to bring the structures up to code.

Over the past twelve months, the Board of Directors has developed schematic drawings for review and feedback from members, has actively solicited member input, and has reviewed several designs incorporating that input. The Board has selected an affordable design that meets the needs of the Association and our members.

The Board of Directors is excited and pleased to announce that the May 18, 2013 Board Meeting will be conducted at the barn/silo and used to present the final design for the SVRA Member Center! There will be a 3D visual presentation by the architect and large schematic drawings will be displayed for up close study and review. We invite and encourage all of our members to plan on attending.
