Water Project CONTINUES

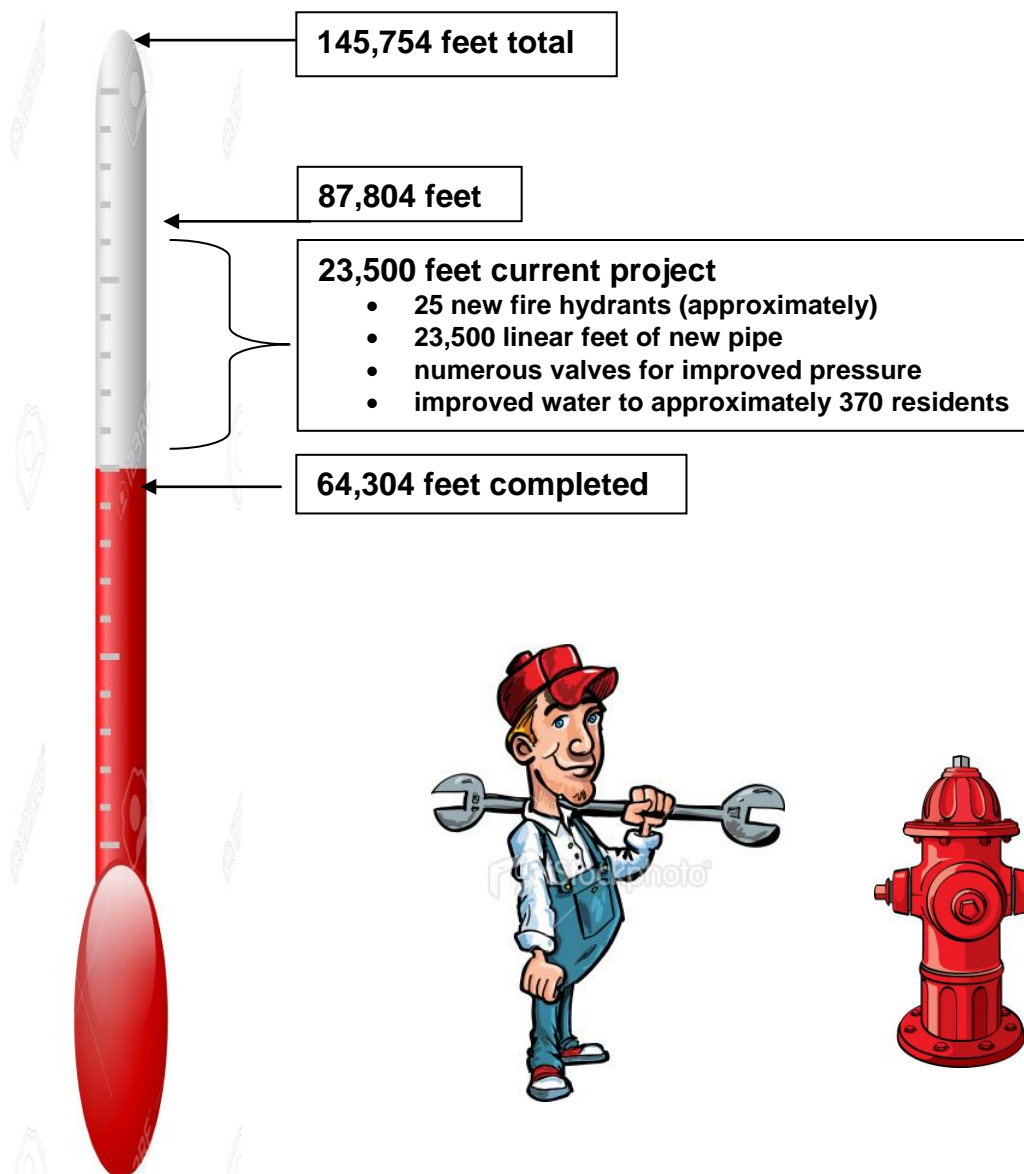
Have you ever wondered how big our Town water project is?

There has been 64,304 feet of pipe replaced.

Our current project will replace another 23,500 feet, which the Town of Star Valley Ranch was recently approved for 2.9 million in funding for the first phase of a 12 million dollar PVC pipe replacement project. This project will replace PVC pipe that is over 40 years old, undersized, inadequate in depth, and has inadequate valves.



Note that once this current project is completed, there is still another 57,950 feet to replace. This has been and continues to be a huge project, but we are making progress!

Water Meter Reminders

There are several instances where residents are landscaping over their water meters.
Please refer to our friendly "Do Not Do" list below.

- **Do not place rocks on the lids**
- **Do not build structures or landscape around the lids**
 - **Do not drive on the lids**

We place a post in front of the lid to protect them and to help us locate them in the winter, so please don't remove it. Repairs can be costly and will get charged to homeowners.

ANIMAL LICENSE APPLICATION

Please **READ** and **Follow** these instructions in order to avoid inconvenience and additional costs to you at a later date.

1. All dogs or cats over six-months old shall be licensed within thirty (30) days of taking residence in the Town.
2. Each dog or cat license shall expire on **December 31st** of the calendar year for which it is issued and each dog or cat shall be licensed annually thereafter.
3. Registration fees will be waived for Certified Service Dog or Cat with proof of Certification as prescribed by a Physician or a Certified Trainer.
4. No licensing fee will be prorated for a partial year nor shall a refund be issued for any license fee already paid.
5. License is not transferable. In the event the License is lost or destroyed during the calendar year for which it was issued, a duplicate will be issued at a fee of \$2.
6. The owner's signed confirmation of address and contact information along with the animal's current spayed/neutered (altered) and rabies vaccination receipt from a certified veterinarian shall be required for registration and license renewals.
